Medicaid is a government-run program that helps low-income individuals receive health insurance.

## **Medicaid Facts:**

- $\Rightarrow$  Serves low-income individuals making \$16,355 or less
- ⇒ Serves families (a couple with a salary of \$22,065 or below)

## **Medicaid Eligible Services**

Services from a Physician, Midwife, or Nurse Practitioner

Nursing Home Services (for those 21 years old +)

Home Health Services for people who qualify for nursing home care

Pregnancy and family planning related services and supplies

Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC) and Rural Health Clinics visits

Emergency care for non-citizens

Early and periodic screening diagnosis
