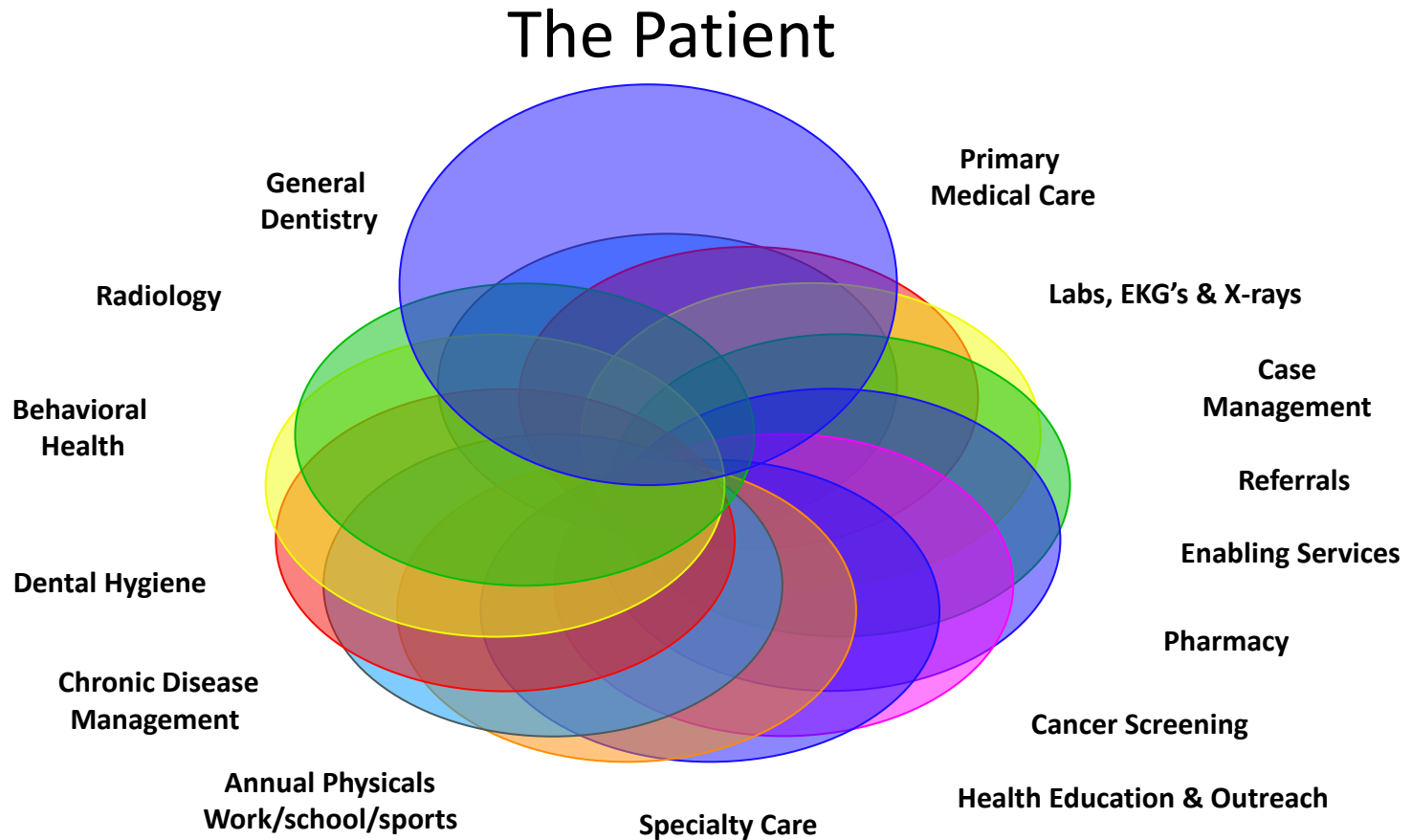

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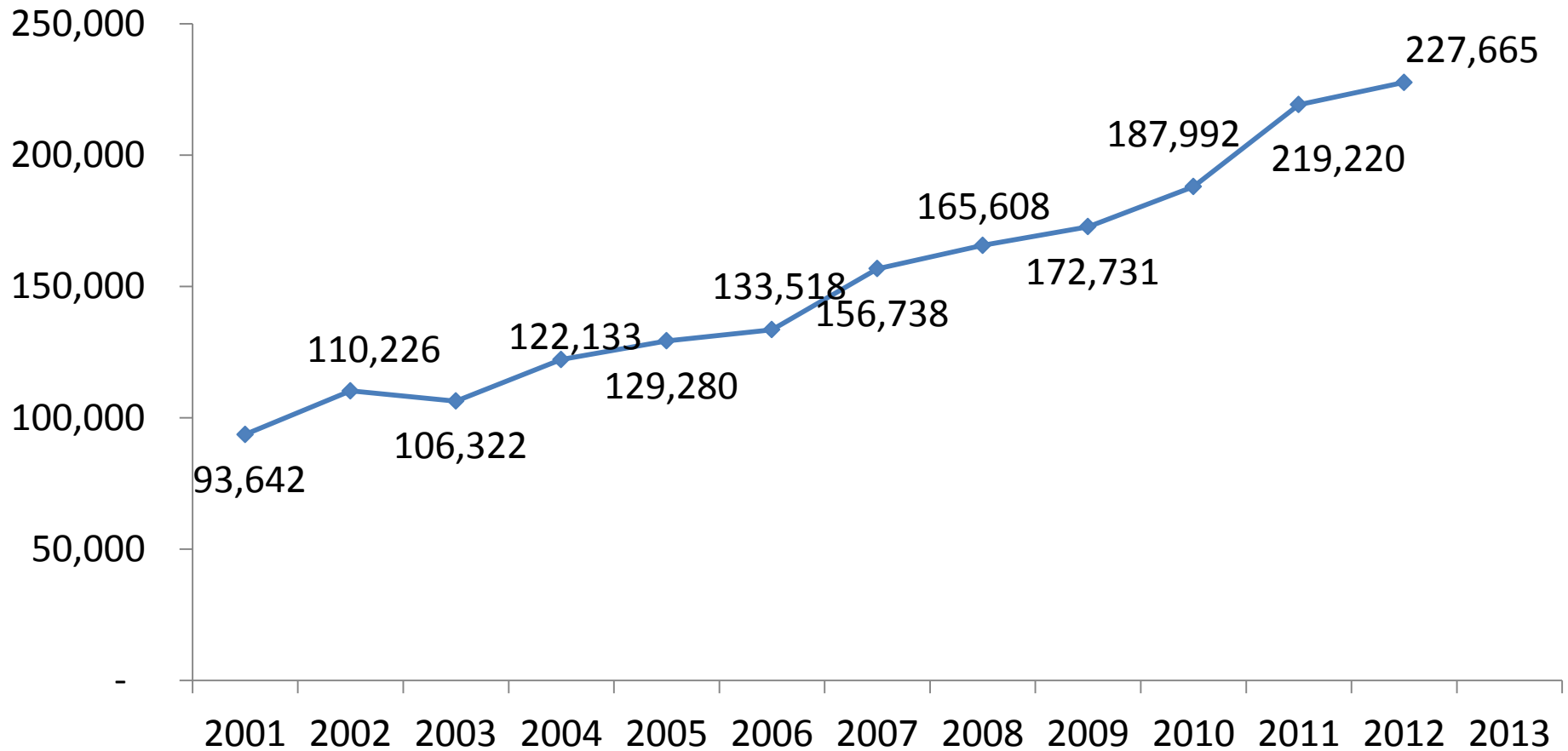

# Patients Served by PHPC Programs

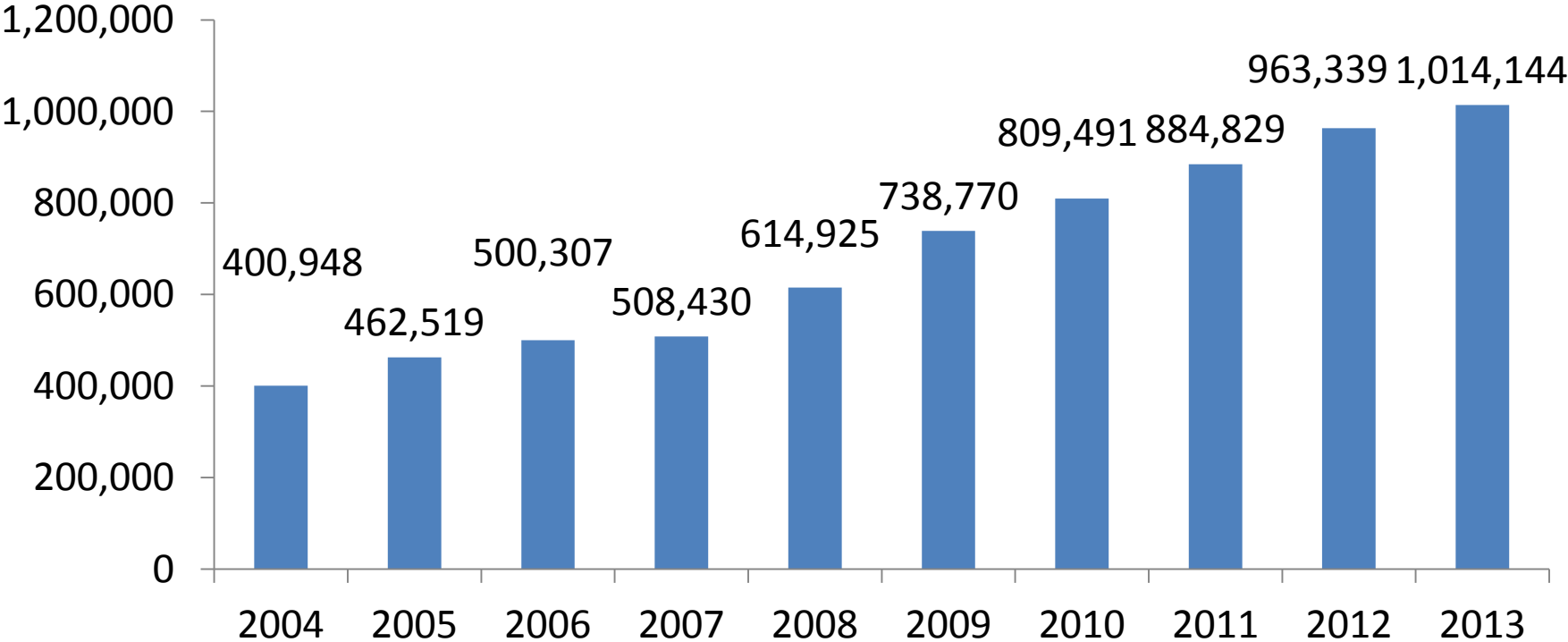
*In 2013, about 227,665 public housing residents were given care and services.*

## Number of Patients Served by PHPC Programs Over Time



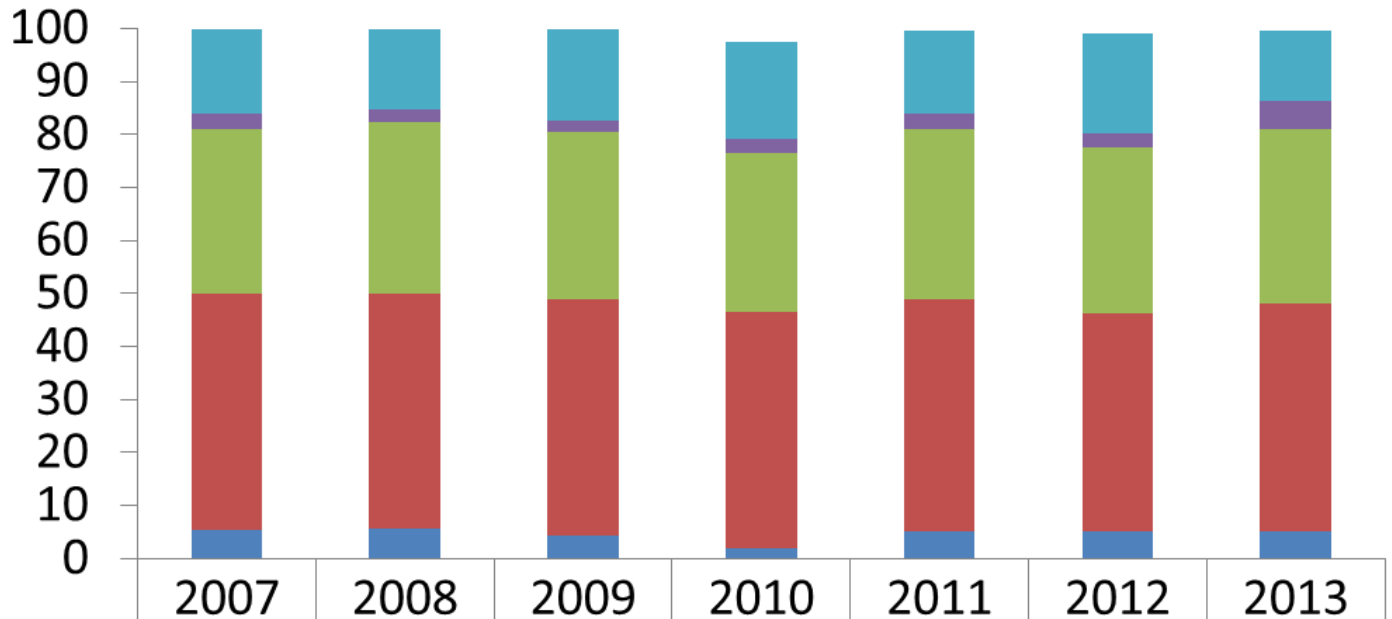
# Total Number of Patient Visits

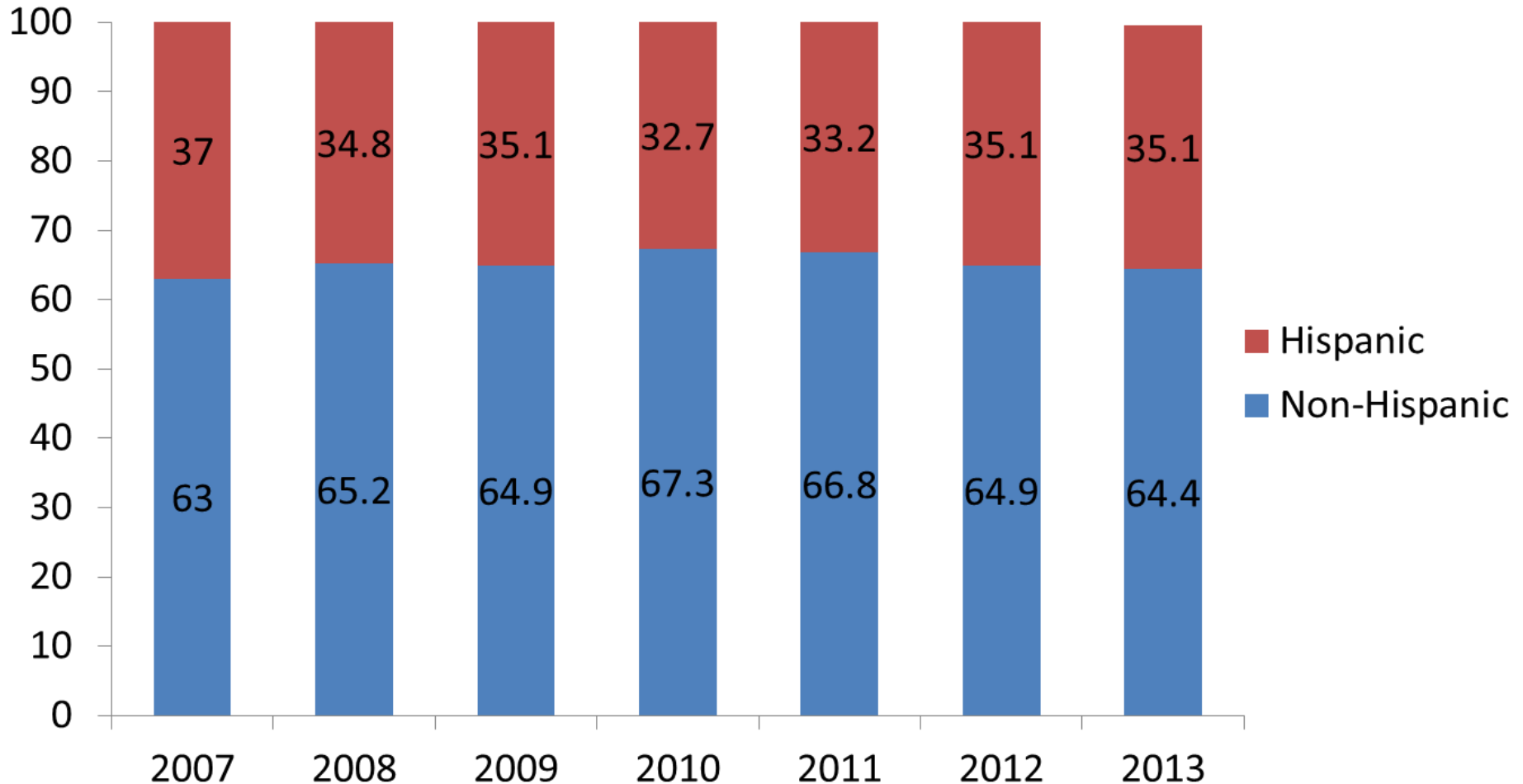

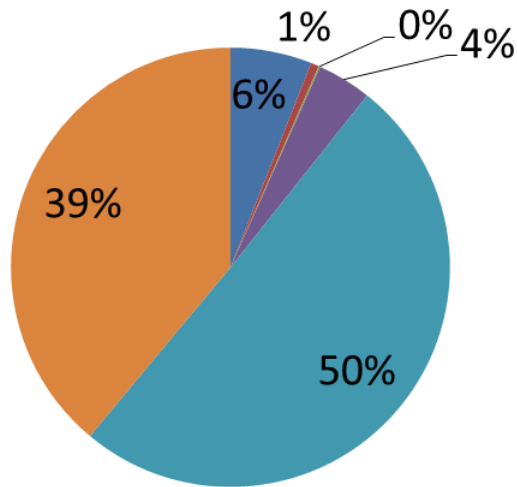

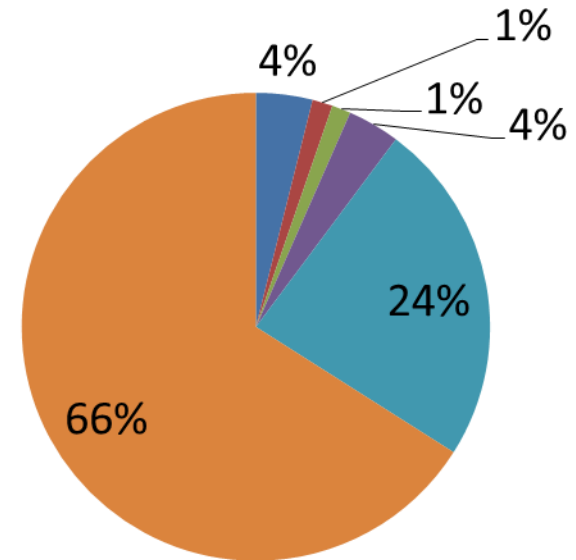

### 2013 PHPC Patient Race/Ethnicity



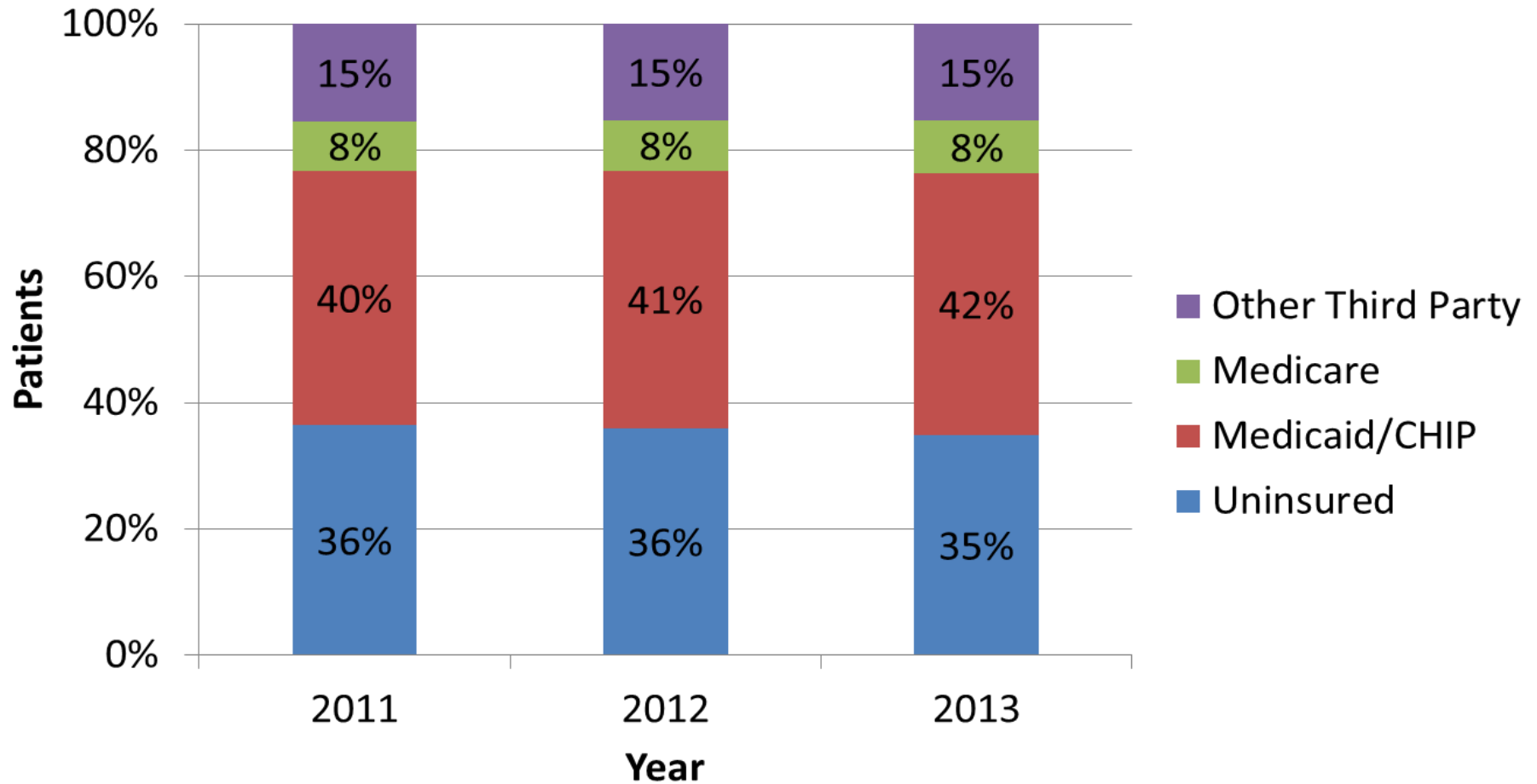

\*Only 15.8% of PHPC children (ages 0-17) were uninsured in 2013.

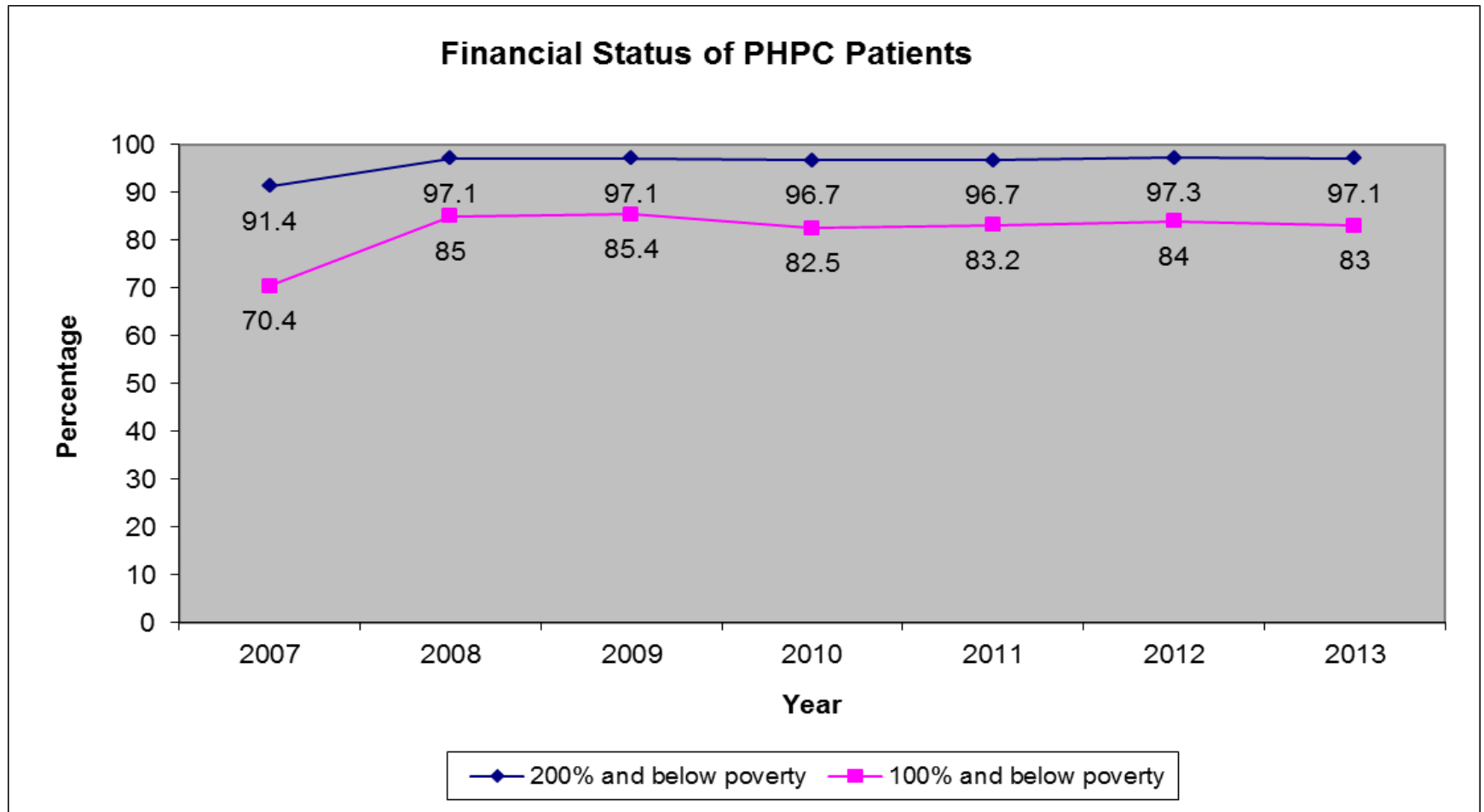


# Age of PHPC Patients in 2013

- Patients are comprised of:
  - youth ages 0-17 (32%)
  - adults age 18-64 (62%) and
  - seniors age 65 and older (6%)

There has been a 7.8% increase in the number of patients age 65 and over in the last 3 years.

# Significant Changes In Visits (2011 to 2013)

## **Selected Other Medical Conditions**

- 87% increase in the number of obesity and overweight visits
- 59% increase in the number of asthma visits
- 58% increase in the number of hypertension visits
- 70% increase in the number of tobacco use disorders visits
- 6% increase in the number of Health Supervision visits of infant or children ages 0-11

## **Selected Diagnostic Tests/Screening/Preventive Services**

- 28% increase in the number of visits for HIV test.
- 24% increase in the number of visits for an oral exam.
- 9% decrease in the number of visits for select immunizations.

# Mental Health Services

In the last 5 years, PHPCs have had a:

- 60% increase in Depression and Other Mood disorder visits
- 70% increase in Other Mental Disorder visits
